




LET'S GO CAMPING!

How do I get there?

Take I-80 East from Salt Lake City, or I-84 East from Ogden, to Coalville, Utah. From Main Street in Coalville go east on 100 N, which becomes Chalk Creek Road. Pinecliff is located 18 miles east on the right-hand side of the road and is clearly marked.



What activities are there at Pinecliff?
